We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Kenowa Hills Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact the building principal, Mike Dodge, for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the <u>MI School Data Parent Dashboard</u>, or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Kenowa Hills Middle School is not identified as TSI, ATS, or CSI.

We are dedicated to creating the best possible learning environment for our students, where every child has the opportunity to thrive and succeed. Our commitment to fostering growth and academic excellence drives us to continually explore innovative strategies to enhance student learning, which ultimately leads to improved outcomes and increased test scores.

While there is still progress to be made in Math and among specific subgroups—including Hispanic, African American, Limited English Proficient (LEP) students, and students with disabilities—our team remains steadfast in its commitment to ongoing growth and success.

Through strategies such as providing a guaranteed and viable curriculum, utilizing an effective instructional framework, and implementing a multi-tiered system of support, we are making strides toward even greater achievement.

Kenowa Hills Middle School assigns students to its school based on district geographic boundaries. The school also participates in the Kent Intermediate School District Schools of Choice Program, the State of Michigan Section 105c Schools of Choice Program, and Section 6 student transfer process.
