Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Pathways High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact the building principal, Cathy Capy-Cantu, for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the <u>MI School Data Parent Dashboard</u>, or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not received a label from the state of MI based on Alternative Education status.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL- Students entering Pathways High School must complete all district registration requirements.

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Then students must complete an application and have a parent/guardian meeting with the principal. The school also participates in the Kent Intermediate School District Schools of Choice Program, the State of Michigan Section 105c Schools of Choice Program, and Section 6 student transfer process.

All tests are administered following the State of MI timeline.

The ongoing communication between the classroom teacher, students and parents is crucial to a student's success. In the fall of 2023-2024 Pathways had a 90% ratio of attendance. Spring 2023-2024 conferences were held with a 75% ratio of attendance. Conferences were held virtually, in-person or over the phone which created challenges for both staff and families.
