Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Zinser Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact the building principal, Brooke Johnston, for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the <u>MI School Data Parent Dashboard</u>, or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels, but like all schools challenges do exist at Zinser and continuous improvements are expected. One of our main challenges is getting our economically disadvantaged students to be a higher achieving subgroup. Reading levels in our middle grades are still lower than normal for us. District and school initiatives to accelerate achievement and close persistent gaps includes: targeted assistance with students through intervention and after

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school tutoring, additional instructional coaching for ELA, LETRS training for all teachers to support reading instruction, an intentional and continued focus on social emotional learning and positive behavior interventions and supports, and an intentional focus surrounding Capturing Kids Hearts and staff to student relationships.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

The school also participates in the Kent Intermediate School District Schools of Choice Program, the State of Michigan Section 105c Schools of Choice Program, and Section 6 student transfer process.
